## Guided Tours ⓘ

Tickets (free) are needed for all tours, except ship tours. Get your tickets at the main information tent, near the wave energy display in front of the Visitor Center. (Tickets will not be given out more than 75 minutes in advance of any tour time.)

All tours meet at the information tent except for ship tours which meet on dock.

### Molluscan Broodstock Facility Tour (60 min) at 11:30 am & 2:00 pm

The aquaculture program at HMSC is focused on several different research topics. These include the Molluscan Broodstock Program (MBP) that is designed to improve broodstock of Pacific oysters through selective breeding so that the public can be supplied with better oysters. There will be tours of the MBP hatchery and nursery showing how algae and oysters are cultured.

### Seawater System Tour (30 min) at 11:00 am, 1:00 pm & 2:30 pm

Tour of OSU's water filtration facilities will include an overall tour of the seawater distribution system. A skilled technician will take visitors through the circuit through which one million gallons of water flow daily as it is pumped, stored, filtered, distributed and cleaned. They will see the computer monitoring system, the UV and sand filters, and the alarms that keep things operating.

### Aquatic Animal Husbandry Tour (45 min) at 11:00 am, 1:00 pm & 2:30 pm

During the tour of HMSC Visitor Center facilities/ Animal Husbandry facility in the back wing of the Visitor Center, visitors will follow an Aquarist and see how animals and exhibits are prepared for display. The "behind the scenes tour" consists of walking down to the west wing area and explaining the work of supporting the animals in the Visitors Center through hospital, quarantine and animal management areas as well as supporting the aquarium sciences program at the community college through education and hands on work.

### Estuary Trail Walks at 10:15, 11:45 am & 2:30 pm

The Estuary Walk is about 1-mile long and follows a paved path. It will be led by an experienced HMSC interpreter who will show the plants, animals, and forces that make estuaries some of the most important and productive habitats in the world.

### Ship tours – at the dock between 12pm to 4pm (ongoing)

Visitors are invited to tour R/V Pacific Storm and learn about this vessel's use in tracking whales. Visitors are also invited to step aboard the R/V Elakha, used for nearshore ocean research

# Getting around at SeaFest

Getting to and from SeaFest is easy. Parking is available at the Hatfield Marine Science Center, and volunteers will be on hand to help you find the right space to park. Parking along OSU Drive near the Hatfield Center is not allowed.

Overflow parking is available at the Oregon Coast Aquarium, and a free shuttle will be run-

ning between the Aquarium parking lot and the Hatfield Center. The Shuttle will also ride out to the OSU dock, providing transportation to the research vessels and dockside exhibits

Bike racks will be available in the Volunteer Parking Lot, and volunteer police will be patrolling the area during the day.

In addition to the free local parking shuttle, an inexpensive shuttle runs through Newport with stops at the Hatfield Center and the Oregon Coast Aquarium. The shuttle costs \$1 per person. Park in town and catch the shuttle out to Hatfield for SeaFest!

**“Newport City Loop,” runs from 8 AM to 6:13 PM, Seven days a week.**

The cost is \$1 per ride (free passes available for visitors via their lodging facility management.)

The loop, with 46 stop options, goes south to Newport Business Plaza in South Beach and north to NE 73rd Street. The bus is wheelchair accessible and has a bike rack. Schedules are available: online, on any bus, at the transit office at 410 NE Harney St., Newport. Call 265-4900.
