- The energy conservation contract was award to McKinstry and work has begun.
 - We still need the map showing the back way across the mountains in case 101 is closed both ways.
 - Les Schwab Tires will take car/boat batteries for free if you call in advance.
 - Surplus chemicals will be picked up by OSU Safety Friday, July 18, and there will be a regular monthly pick-up. Waste generated by OSU personnel in the federal NAL and RSF buildings will remain in those buildings for NOAA waste processing.
 - The Education Building elevator has been repaired and a bid has been received for installing an anti-egress device.
 - The building numbers are still not up yet.
 - Our OSU fire extinguishers will now be maintained by OSU instead of Valley Fire Control.
 - The maintenance staff and custodians will be getting defibrillator training this evening. Defibrillator devices are located in NAL, RSF, the Barry Fisher Building and in EPA.
 - The bearing-wall in 900-009 has been completely replaced by our maintenance staff and they did an excellent job.
