

Safety Meeting Minutes from August 3, 2005

Members present: Randy Walker, Brian Parker, Faith Cole and Lori Parker

New lighting improvements to the NOAA side of the complex was a great portion of the discussion. Brian Parker explained the scope of the project that will increase lighting to meet Homeland Security standards around all NOAA buildings onsite.

Lori Parker said the lighting is inadequate in the parking lot in front of ODF&W and asked if there is a possibility that it may be increased.

Discussion of the proposed siren for Tsunami Warning was discussed and it was felt by the safety Committee that all agencies onsite should help with funding a siren for HMSC. Concern was raised about disturbing the sea lions in the bay during testing of the siren.

Faith Cole mentioned that EPA will be doing some core sampling to determine the stability of the soil at HMSC during an earthquake. All present expressed a desire to see the results of the core testing.
