Purpose:	To honor Maryann Bozza's spirit of collaboration, communication, and passion for providing non- traditional students access to careers in Marine Studies. Maryann was OSU's Hatfield Marine Science Center Program Manager from 2010 to 2017.
Amount:	up to \$2,500
Fund Type:	Award
Support Areas:	Opportunities for non-traditional students seeking hands-on marine studies experiences at the OSU Hatfield Marine Science Center
Duration:	One calendar year: July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025
Deadline:	February 15, 2024

Award Requirements:

- Student status: A student enrolled at any college or university is eligible to apply, however, the project must be conducted using resources at HMSC.
- Reporting: Awardees will be required to submit a final report by May 31, 2025
- Awardees will be required to participate in the 2024 and 2025 Markham Symposiums. The 2024 Markham Symposium will be held on June 20, 2024.

Funding Uses:

• Any expenses that contribute to onsite projects or activities at the Hatfield Marine Science Center.

To Apply:

Applications must be submitted through the online application form at the link below by 11:45 PM on **February 15**, 2024 to be considered. <u>https://oregonstate.qualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_ahPtY1w5LNPIMPY</u>. Applications should be submitted as a single pdf document. Complete your application pdf before you start the online application form.

Your application must include the following documents:

- Cover letter, no longer than one page. The cover letter should include a description of your personal academic and career goals.
- Project description, no longer than two pages including a summary of activities, projects, or opportunities that would be supported by this fund. Highlight your use of HMSC facilities and include your anticipated dates of onsite at the Hatfield Marine Science Center.
- A statement on how you meet the purpose and support areas of this specific award (100 words or less).
- Budget, including a one-page narrative.
- Letter of support from a faculty member. The letter of support can be included in your application document or emailed directly to Cinamon Moffett at moffettc@oregonstate.edu

Criteria:

• The criteria by which applicants will be evaluated include: project merit (creativity, feasibility, and broader implications); use of HMSC facilities; soundness of proposed budget; and adherence to application procedures.
