

Safety Committee Meeting Minutes for September 6, 2006

Walker told that OSU campus is working on a plan to address possible pandemic illness. In the short while, HMSC/OSU is putting up hand sanitizing stations in most bathrooms.

Parker spoke to the flooding issues that frequent the lot in front of ODF&W during winter storms. It was decided that not much can be done to ease this situation, because there is not much elevation to work with to increase flow through the ditch.

It was decided to have the annual HMSC all community Tsunami Drill in October. We will announce the date and time when it gets closer to the middle of October, so that we can look at the long range weather to ensure that we have good weather. Lundeen will prepare a table with recommended disaster items that individuals should carry up to the evacuation site. Walker will get a bull horn for announcements

It was decided that each agency should get a satellite phone to heighten the possibilities of someone bringing a phone to the hill top during evacuation. Next Safety Meeting will be October 4, 2006 in the upstairs foyer area of the Barry Fisher Building at 9:00AM
