I. Presentation for the HMSC Management Committee

The Sustainability Committee is preparing to meet with the HMSC Management group on January 12, 2010. We identified these points for possible inclusion in a powerpoint presentation to be shown at that time:

- a. Mission statement: To promote, demonstrate and implement sustainable practices at HMSC and to encourage adoption of such practices within the HMSC community.
- b. History of the Sustainability Committee
- c. Our three-pronged objectives: education; making sustainable improvements at HMSC as well as in our homes.
- d. Committee accomplishments: Commuter Survey, Brownbags, Recyclemania, recycling bins/program, wormbin, earthtub
- e. Development of Environmental Management System underway (EMS)
- f. Biggest Problem: How best to communicate and coordinate with various HMSC agencies to implement green improvements? How can the Sustainability Committee incorporate itself into these agencies in a positive way that will produce green changes? How can we gather information about what green efforts are already underway around the center that may become more collaborative? Can we visit various agency meetings and work with them on monthly basis?
- g. Ask for buy-in from all HMSC agencies on particular quarterly topics
- h. Goals for committee: get representative from every HMSC agency on our committee; visit other agency committees; create a website
- i. Enumerate some simple green projects that we think can be implemented easily, such as metal recycling and water catchment
- j. Measure baseline data and work toward making improvements in greenhouse gas emmissions; Help move center toward climate neutrality.
- k. Ask Management Committee how they can use this committee. Ask what they see us doing for this campus.

Action: Sharon and Anjanette will prepare the powerpoint presentation; committee will preview it on Jan. 5th meeting.

Action: Tom will present our talk/powerpoint to the Management Committee on Jan. 12th.

We are very glad to have new member, Rick Brown, attending our meeting. He made some helpful suggestions regarding meeting with the HMSC Management group, to which he also belongs. He suggests we ask the management committee how the Sustainability Committee can be used for the benefit of the HMSC campus. Rick believes the largest problem we face is one of communication and collaboration across the many agencies located at HMSC; we need to find a way to implement sustainable practices in an efficient way without duplicating research time and costs. How can our group be inserted into each agency and/or best used at the HMSC campus? What services would the various groups like to see us perform? How can we collaborate on green improvements?

Our committee has grown smaller since a few members have moved away; we hope to recruit new members.
